

SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST FOR SEPTEMBER 2010-2011

Pre K 3

1. Kidnapper Sleep Mat - ( Only if your child is a FULL Day!)
2. Art Box – Pack of Crayons, Glue Stick, Scissors
3. Spare Clothes – Shirt, Pants, Underwear, Socks
4. Lunch Box (no bags).
5. Backpack
6. 2 boxes of tissues
7. 2 rolls of paper towels
8. 2 packs of wipes
9. 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

Kindergarten

1. A Backpack (large enough to fit folders and a lunch box)
  2. Three (3) number two pencils
  3. A Box of at least twelve (12) crayons.
  4. Child Safety scissors
  5. Glue ( one stick and one bottle)
- \*Please have all of these things in a plastic case that snaps shut, labeled with your child's name.
6. Three folders labeled with your child's name.
  7. Two (2) boxes of tissues
  8. Two (2) bottles of hand sanitizer
  - 9 Two (2) rolls of paper towels
- Please do not bring in pencil sharpeners or markers.

First Grade

1. One (1) box of crayons ( 48 or fewer crayons in the box).
  2. One (1) box of washable makers.
  3. Five (5) large solid glue sticks.
  4. One (1) small Elmer's school glue.
  5. One (1) box of #2 sharpened pencils.
  6. Two (2) large pink erasers.
  7. One (1) pair of children's scissors with metal blades.
  8. Six (6) sturdy pocket folders
  9. 1 12" ruler
  10. Three (3) dry erase markers (pen size).
  11. One (1) Plastic pencil box that snaps shut.
- \*Please be sure to write your child's name on each of the above items with a black permanent marker. There will also be a \$2.00 charge at the beginning of the school year to cover the cost of two (2) marble notebooks to be used for journal writing and spelling.

Second Grade

Please label everything with first and last names and the subjects listed below. Please DO NOT use spiral notebooks.

Six (6) NOTEBOOKS for the following subjects:

READING, ENGLISH, SPELLING, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES AND JOURNAL

Four (4) FOLDERS for the following uses:

TAKE HOME/HOMEWORK, PORTFOLIO, TEST FOLDER, READING LOG FOLDER

\* ALSO the following supplies:

1. 1 Art Box
2. Crayons that fit into the art box (Please DO NOT buy the 64 pack of crayons)
3. One (1) pair of scissors
4. Glue Sticks only
5. Ruler
6. Sharpener
7. Pencils – We can never have enough.
8. TWO (2) boxes of tissues
9. TWO (2) bottles of hand sanitizer
10. THREE (3) packs of Index Cards to be used throughout the year.

Third Grade

The list of supplies consist of:

1. One (1) box of crayons (any size)
2. One (1) Glue or glue stick

3. One (1) pair of children's scissors
4. One (1) large eraser
5. One (1) box of sharpened pencils
6. One (1) correcting pen or pencil
7. One (1) large supply box that will hold all of the above items.
8. Four (4) folders (with two pockets)
9. One (1) 12" ruler (with inches and centimeters)
10. One (1) Homework assignment pad
11. Two (2) bottles of hand sanitizer
12. Three (3) boxes of tissues for the classroom

\*Please be advised that the only items that the students are permitted at their desk are two sharpened pencils and one correcting pen or pencil. Fancy pens, pencils, erasers and pencils sharpeners become a distraction during class.

\*Students will also need to have SIX NOTEBOOKS and THREE THEME TABLETS. These will need to be purchased from School. The cost of these materials will be \$11.50. Please send this money with your child on the first day of school.
